240 students are enrolled for the 2022-2023 school year, representing an economic impact of over \$8.6 million. 85% of our students come from abroad and settle in the region for a period of two years or more, with some students staying on to work at the college. 80% of our students have jobs in the local area, helping to offset labour shortages experienced by local businesses. 56 full-time employees who live in the Gatineau area With the increased traffic generated by the arrival of Select Aviation College at the Gatineau airport, a total of \$13.1 million was invested to An investment of \$500K was made to purchase build a new parallel taxiway and a new building of materials and equipment supplied by several adjacent to the terminal.
